If you are a returning vendor, you must file your paid registration by April 1, 2024 to secure your membership in the Market. If a vendor does not summit a paid registration by April 1st, we cannot guarantee your inclusion in the Market.

The Market currently has limited openings in the categories of vegetable sales, jams & jellies and honey. If you plan on selling any of these items, please go ahead and fill out the registration form and return it to us. We will notify you by phone or e-mail, if you are accepted into the market. We should know how many openings we have around April 1st.

Applications for new vendors are processed on a first-come, first-service basis, subject to availability. We will notify you if your application is accepted into the Market.
